Pediatric Emergency Medicine Skills Course

for Registered Nurses

Thursday, April 10, 2025 Nemours Children's Hospital, Delaware



This is an intensive one day course designed for Emergency Department Registered Nurses who would like more experience in managing pediatric emergency scenarios. We will provide hands on training in critical pediatric assessment and procedure skills. This will include pediatric specific triage techniques, airway management, vascular access, immobilization, and resuscitation procedures. Using high fidelity simulation, this course will also focus on the crisis resource management skills needed to successfully manage a critically ill pediatric patient.

Learning Objectives

- Discuss the initial and ongoing assessment of a pediatric patient including system specific interventions
- Discuss priorities of care in pediatrics
- Identify potential indicators of child abuse and neglect
- Describe the management of neonatal emergencies
- List unique features of the pediatric airway
- Describe techniques to obtain vascular access in neonatal and pediatric patients

- Identify indicators of illness and injury in the pediatric patient
- List appropriate medications used in pediatric resuscitation
- Discuss the newest recommendations for advanced life support in pediatric patients
- Manage complex children in the Emergency Department
- Develop an approach to common and unusual pediatric illnesses encountered in the Emergency Department


