Anderson Collier, MD joined Nemours in May 2023 and is the Division Chief of the Hematology-Oncology department after practicing at the University of Mississippi Medical Center in Jackson, Mississippi. He was division chief of the Department of Pediatrics, the D. Jeannette Pullen Endowed Chair of Pediatric Hematology-Oncology, and professor in the School of Medicine. He earned his Bachelor of Science in Molecular Biology and his Doctor of Medicine degrees from Vanderbilt University in Nashville, Tenn. He completed his residency in pediatrics and then fellowship in Pediatric hematology/oncology at the University of Texas at Southwestern Medical Center in Dallas where he was an active researcher and the institutional principal investigator of the Children's Oncology Group.

Janet Leon, DO is a pediatric neurologist at Nemours Children's Health and will be joining the faculty in the fall of 2024 after completing her residency in Child and Adolescent Neurology at Mayo Clinic in Jacksonville. She previously completed a residency in General Pediatrics at the University of Florida in Jacksonville. She earned her Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine and a Master of Science from Nova Southeastern University in Davie, FL. She has a special interest in headache management.

Stephanie S. Pearce, MD is the Director of Sports Medicine and joined the Nemours orthopedic surgery department in September 2023 after practicing in Virginia. She is a dual fellowship trained sports medicine surgeon and pediatric orthopedic surgeon. Dr. Pearce completed orthopedic surgery residency at the University of South Alabama. She continued her training with a fellowship in pediatric orthopedic surgery at Children's Hospital Colorado in Denver and a second fellowship in sports medicine orthopedic surgery at the prestigious Steadman Clinic in Vail, Colorado. She is active in several national organizations and focuses her research and clinical activity on complex knee, elbow, shoulder, and hip injuries and conditions, as well as cartilage preservation.
