# EVENT OVERVIEW

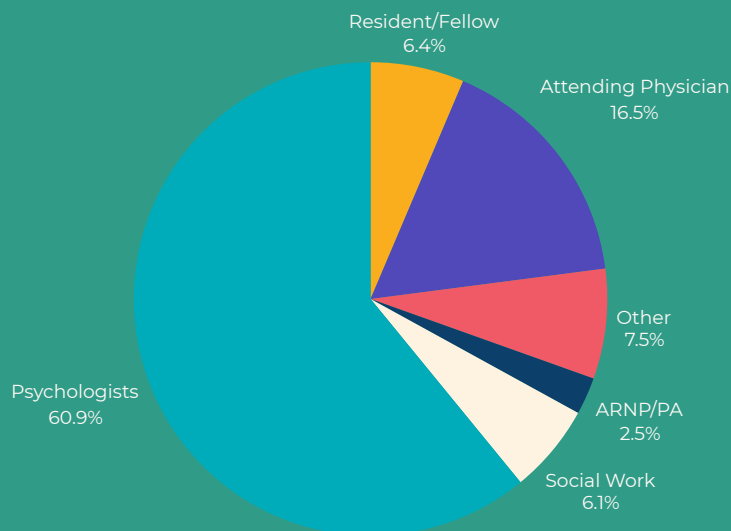
The fifth biennial DREAM IPC Conference will be held September 17-19, 2025 at the Chase Center on the Riverfront in Wilmington, Delaware.
